Questions

1. The Bible is one book, which is made up of 66 books: Name the books of the Bible; Explain their differences: Some are long, some short, history, poetry, prophecy, and letters to churches.

But what makes the Bible unique is that it is **God’s Word** (2 Tim. 3:16-17). When we read the Bible, it’s the same as if God were to come and speak to us Himself.

2. There are other books that people claim are God’s Word, such as the Mormon book *Pearl of Great Price* or the Muslim book *The Koran*, but they aren’t.

There are people who claim that God speaks through them, but He doesn’t.

The only way God speaks today outside the Bible is in His Creation (Ps. 19:1-2; Rom. 1:20). Creation shows us that God is infinitely powerful, wise, and good.

3. We should listen to everything it says.

We should obey His commandments, believe His promises and tremble at His threatenings.

Gospel: God has told us what He wants us to do in His Word (Ex. 20), but each of us has sinned by disobeying Him (Rom. 3:23). God will punish everyone who disobeys Him forever in hell (Rev. 20:15). But He has also promised to save everyone who will believe in His Son Jesus and who will turn from their sins (Acts 16:31). (Chose one commandment, show how they have broken it, tell them they should be afraid of the Lord’s judgment and believe God’s promise to give them life through Jesus).
