Pray & Review Q6. *Is there more than one true god? - No. There is only one true God.*

Read Matt 28:19-20

Questions

1. **One.** There is only one true God; all the other "gods" that people worship are false gods. (Isa. 44:6-8; 45:5-6; Ps. 96:5)
2. The true God is very different from the other 'gods'. He is only one God, but He is three persons. We cannot fully understand how He is like this, but we know that He is from His Word. God is three in person but is one substance, one thing, one infinite spirit. Use Gen. 1:26 and Matt. 28:19-20 to show plurality in the Godhead.

This is called the **Trinity**. (Unity = oneness, Trinity = 'threeness')

3. **Yes.** This is what God is. If you believe He is different than this, you do not believe in the true God, and only the true God can save you. (This stands to reason: if God defines Himself as being one God in three persons, if we believe otherwise, we are wrong and are believing in a false god).

Gospel: You must believe that God is three persons to be saved! God the Father created everything, God the Son died to save His people, God the Holy Spirit applies salvation to the elect. Are you worshipping Him?
