Review Q23 What covenant did God make with Adam?
- *The covenant of works.*

Also

A covenant is an agreement that puts two people in a relationship with each other. Covenants between two people are usually agreed upon by both parties.

The covenant of life was made by God to Adam who represented all mankind. He and all of his posterity would inherit eternal life if Adam obeyed God perfectly.

Questions

1. Obedience was the condition that the Lord gave to Adam and not even one sin was possible or else death would come into this world through Adam.
2. Yes, Adam owed God obedience regardless. The creature is bound to keep his Creator's commands no matter what.
