A. 30 Doing what God forbids.

Scripture Base: Ex 20:1-17; 1 Sam. 13,

Teaching Notes

Review: Q29. What is meant by want of conformity?
- *Not being or doing what God requires.*

Story: **1 Sam 13. Saul's disobedience and its consequences.** *Also review Adam & Eve's committing an act against God's Law. They suffered and so do we as a result.*

Questions:

- 1 To break it. (If we use the Lord's name in vain, we transgress/break God's Law, because He told us not to... etc.) Whenever we do what God forbids, we transgress or break God's commandment.
- 2 By NOT DOING what God commands (sins of omission), or by DOING things He has specifically commanded us NOT to do (sins of commission).
- 3 God is holy, and wants us to do what is good, right, just and loving. Anything we do that is not good, right, just and loving, both towards Him and towards our neighbor (Matt. 22:37-40), is an offense to Him.
How do we know what's good, right, just and loving?
God tells us in His commandments, and He has to tell us because we can be wrong.

Gospel: Have you ever done anything that God has told you not to do? [Loved anything/one more than Him (1st)? Review several - wanted anything that doesn't belong to you (10th)? If so, you've transgressed God's Law and have sinned (1 Sam. 15:24).]

What is the penalty for sin? Death! (Rom. 6:23).

If you don't turn from your sins to Jesus, then you will have to pay that penalty. But if you repent of your sins and trust in Jesus to save you, He will forgive you and give you eternal life.
