Questions

1 What does *elect* mean?

Chosen by God for salvation.

One chosen or set apart - Webster’s 1828:

Scripture: Eph 1:3 -6; Rom. 8: 28-30; 1 Peter 2:9-12;
Romans 9:10-26

Example: Jacob and **not** Esau - Romans 9

2 When did God choose those He did?

In eternity. Before creation. Eph.1:3, 4

3 Why did God choose His elect people?

For His own glory.

Because it pleased Him to do so. Romans 9:23-24

Also to give them to His son as a reward. Is 53:10, 66:22

Gospel: We can do nothing to make God choose us.
God’s elect are those who have turned to Him for salvation in repentance and faith. We must seek Him and ask Him to change our hearts.
