Q82. What is the second commandment?

- "You shall not make for yourself an idol, or any likeness of what is in heaven above, or on the earth beneath, or in the water under the earth. You shall not worship them or serve them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, on the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me, but showing lovingkindness to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments."

Supplementary Questions

3. We are to pray to God (*Phil. 4:6*).

His Word is to be read and preached. (*Acts 15:21, 2 Timothy 4:1-2*).

We are to hear and do the Word (*James 1:22*).

We are to worship Him with psalms, hymns & spiritual songs (*Eph. 5:19*).

We are to receive the sacraments of baptism and the Lord's Supper. (*Matt. 28:19, 1 Corinthians 11:23-26*).

4. He promises blessing: "Showing lovingkindness to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments" (Ex. 20:6).

- *What about those who won't keep His commandments?* "For I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, on the third and the fourth generations of those who hate Me" (v. 5).

Gospel: Are you a worshiper of the true God? Are you worshiping Him in the way He wants you to worship Him? And are you worshiping Him for the right reason. Jesus tells you, "You shall worship the Lord your God, and serve Him only" (Matt. 4:10); and He says, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind" (22:37). Do you worship Him because you love Him for who He is (and not just for what He has done for you, although that is still important?). If not, then look to Jesus to help you. He can make you love God so that you will want to worship Him as He commands with your whole life.
